

How to Find Your State Senator and Representative

United States Senators for Pennsylvania (Federal Government)

1. Go online to <http://www.senate.gov/>
2. Go to “Find Your Senators—Choose a State”
3. Choose “Pennsylvania”
4. You will be presented with the names of both Pennsylvania U.S. senators

United States Representative for Pennsylvania (Federal Government)

1. You need to know your zip code+4. If you do not know it:
 - a. Go to <http://www.usps.com> – the U.S. Postal Service web site
 - b. Click “Find a Zip code” and follow the on-screen instructions
2. Go online to <http://www.house.gov/>
3. Enter your zip code+4 in the boxes under “Find Your Representative” and click “Go”
4. You will be presented with the name of your U.S. representative, plus the number of your Congressional legislative district

Pennsylvania State Senator and Representative (State Government)

1. Go online to <http://www.legis.state.pa.us/>
 - a. In the upper right hand corner of the homepage for the Pennsylvania General Assembly is a box labeled “Find Members By.” You can search by county. Click on your county.
 - b. You will be presented with the names of both your state senator and your state representative, as well as the numbers of your state senate and house districts
 - c. Click on a name to be taken to biographical information on that person
